5. A special award will be given for best design harmony for site at Awards Committee discretion

How To Enter:

Entries should be submitted to Awards Committee including:

Up to ten color photos (digital is fine) and written description of circumstances surrounding the design and installation or maintenance schedule. Describe site, any existing landscape features, grade changes, client desires and budget, etc.

For landscape entries, landscape drawing is strongly suggested. Please submit all entries in a manila envelope or folder. (digital is fine for prints as well)

- A limit of two awards per category will be granted per year.
- Winners will be presented with a plaque at the winter banquet and also will be required to develop a poster display. Posters will be visible during social time at the banquet.

2018 Landscape Awards Guidelines

Deadline for entries:
Thursday, January 3, 2019

Landscape Entries - will be judged for overall landscape harmony using general landscape design principles including:

Scale
Balance
Repetition
Unity
Dominance

These principles should demonstrate excellent use of the following Artistic elements:

Line, Form, Color, Texture, Site & Design Harmony

Maintenance Entries - will be judged for proper pruning practices, overall fertility, IPM practices and overall appearance including:

Edging
Weed Control in Lawn & Beds
Proper Bed Grooming
Proper Herbaceous Plant Grooming

(site should have been maintained by a company for at least two consecutive years)
