# Proud of one of our AGRLP members.....

Woodland Tree Services, Inc. congratulate, and are proud to announce that our own, Lucas Drews, climbing I.S.A. Certified Arborist, as represented the Michigan Chapter, Arboriculture Society of Michigan at the International Tree Climbing Championship held in San Antonio, TX, April 2 & 3, 2016. There he competed against 43 other top male climbers from all over the world. He placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the preliminary competition, which consists of 5 events. Competitors are scored individually in each event-Aerial Rescue, Work Climb, Secured Footlock, Belayed Speed Climb, and Throwline. The competitor with the highest score is the winner of that event. There they move on to the Master's, with a clean slate. There he took 4<sup>th</sup> place with a score of 193.33 points, just .67 points behind the French competitor that took 3<sup>rd</sup> Place! The top male placers were: Top 5 Competitors- End results –5th: Derrik Martin - Penn Del; 3rd – Jerome Pagny - France; 4th - Lucas Drews – Michigan; 1st -James Kilpatrick – New Zealand; 2nd –Barton-Allen Hall – Australia.
