Tom Creswell, Clinical Engagement Professor and Director of the Plant and Pest Diagnostic Lab (PPDL) at Purdue University, diagnoses plant disease problems and coordinates activities of other Extension experts in a collaborative approach to identification of disease, insect, horticultural and agronomic problems.
